This course contains 35 hours of guided tuition over 5 days (*). Below is the proposed Agenda for the course in <u>Madeira Island</u>. The course is held mostly at the <u>Teachers Training Division of Regional Directorate of</u> <u>Education</u>, but participants will have the opportunity to visit other schools/divisions.

Language used for the training: English.

Target group: Kindergarten teachers, preschool teachers, primary teachers, secondary teachers, Special education teachers, headteachers/principles, deputy heads, future head teachers, trainers, councilors, researchers, politicians and other stakeholders.

Description: The course has been designed to provide tools to prepare European teachers for a future that happens today. One of the main purposes of today's education is to build a school for students, where they

can interact with their peers of the same age group and be active agents of the learning community. An inclusive school implements and develops a set of measures aimed at giving response to each and every student's needs through the acknowledgement and the valuing of difference. The course is designed to be very practical, demonstrative and interactive. The trainers are enthusiastic educational agents, namely teachers with a broad experience and actively involved in Inclusive Education.
