Other activities should complement the formal learning activities to enhance social, cultural and professional interactions between participants.”

Target group: kindergarten teachers, preschool teachers, primary teachers, secondary teachers, headmasters, deputy heads, future head teachers, trainers, councilors, researchers, politicians and others stakeholders.

Language used for the training: English

Description: The course has been designed to provide tools to prepare European teachers for a future that happens today. The goal is to empower teachers with skills in the English language (A2-B2 level), so that they can use the language pedagogically in class, in lesson planning and when contacting people around the world. At the same time they will also be able to apply the language when using digital technology. The course is designed to be very practical, demonstrative and interactive. The trainers are enthusiastic educational agents, namely teachers with a broad experience and actively involved in 21st Century Skills.

Course Objectives:

- Acquire intermediate-level language and vocabulary forms.
- Maximize the opportunity to speak and communicate in English.
- Improve language skills, especially the oral fluency of participants.
- Enable participants to use English in everyday life situations.
- Improve language skills using technology.
- Get to know the culture of Madeira/Portugal using the English language.
- Discuss the importance of the school's internationalization process.
- Draft a school policy plan on internationalization.
- Understand the importance of eTwinning for the school's internationalization process.
