**Target group:** kindergarten teachers, pre-school teachers, primary teachers, secondary teachers, headmasters, deputy heads, future head teachers, trainers, councilors, researchers, politicians and others stakeholders.

- Promote educational innovation and stimulating the use of ICT in schools;
- Promoting interdisciplinary through STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics);
- Develop methodologies, strategies, techniques and resources for a differentiated teaching;
- Create spin-off effects like curriculum development and research collaboration;
- Improve educational practices through collaborative working approaches among teachers;
- Promote a deeper understanding of the practical ways of incorporating eTwinning in teaching;
- Improve the quality and efficacy of the management of international projects;
- Increase knowledge of social, linguistic and cultural matters.

#### Costs

All costs can be supported with a grant under Key Action 1 of the Erasmus+ programme.

**Course Fees:** 420€ for a 6-day course

**Admin & Organizational Fees:** 150€ per participant

(Includes: pedagogical and intercultural support; training materials; validation of learning outcomes; certification; validation of Europass Mobility; admin and organizational costs; transport for school visits. Institutions will receive from Erasmus+ founding 350€ per participant for "Organizational Support" - the remaining 200€ per participant will be kept by the participant institution).
